PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Dear Community Members,

2011 is swiftly coming to an end, how quickly a year has gone by! The most important event this year, the 5th World Zoroastrian Youth Congress which took place in the first week of July, concluded extremely successfully. We are also very proud to have had the sedreh pushi (navjote) of two children done at the Dar-e Mehr in May. Several sessions of seniors were held during this year and many other activities were conducted. All this is not possible without the dedication and precious time provided by volunteers. The Zarathushti New Year beginning March 20, 2012 is the year 3750. The first Zoroastrian calendar was maintained for 300 years after Zarathushtra brought his message, but it fell into disuse because of disturbed days that followed the fall of the Kayanian Dynasty. However, today the Zoroastrians of Iran accept the dates 1767 BCE as the year of birth, 1738 BCE as the year of His being Chosen to be a Prophet, and 1690 BCE as the year of the passing away of Zarathushtra. citizenU

What is the citizenU program?

citizenU is a nine-month anti-racism, anti-discrimination and community building program. From the beginning, youth have had voice in its development. As participants, you will enhance your capacity to address these issues through community engagement and leadership development. The program is free to all participants, food and bus tickets will be provided, and school credits are available for participation. *So, how does it work?*

The program will take place at different community organizations around the city and you will participate through one of these host sites. Your commitment will be for about 2 hours a week for 9 months, which will be divided into three phases:

Phase 1: Receive *capacity-building training workshops* at your local host site/organization about intercultural communications, diversity and anti-discrimination.

Phase 2: Participate in city-wide intercultural, intergenerational, and interfaith activities such as neighbourhood exchanges, community forums, and arts, sports, and recreation activities, including the opportunity to work with other community organizations.

Phase 3: Build your own *intercultural youth action team* and get training, support, and funding to create and implement your own projects!

Ok sounds cool, but why?

Throughout the project, you will get to meet diverse youth from across the city who also want to reduce discrimination and promote community building. citizenU will support your events and projects to help build bridges between communities.

You will gain **leadership skills** that you can apply to your everyday life. *learn by action*, not by sitting and talking! You will also leave the program with a large **network** of peers and adult allies that you can work with over the coming years.

School credits are available for participation, and at the end you'll receive a certificate as a record of your accomplishments.

What You Need To Know To Register and Get Involved in citizenU Program:

The citizenU Program is targeted towards youth in Vancouver to help them further develop the skills they need to create a positive change in our world. The program is geared towards engaging youth between the ages of 15-25 through training workshops, city wide events and activities, as well as project implementation in the Vancouver community. The program is funded by Citizenship and Immigration Canada.

The program will take place in three phases over the course of the next nine months. Youth will be required to commit their time and participate in all three phases. Phase One begins in November 2011 and ends in January 2012. Participating youth will be expected to attend all of the various activity and workshop sessions that will take place until the end of January 2012. A total commitment of around 20 hours will be required for Phase One. All sessions are mandatory for attendance so please mark your calendars for the dates.

All sessions will take place at the **Arbab Rustom Guiv Darbe Mehr at 6900 Halifax Street, Burnaby, BC** unless specified otherwise.

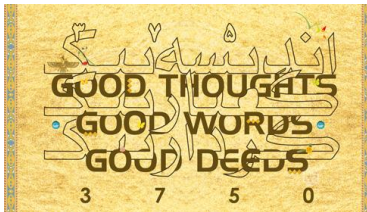

WHAT'S HAPPENING

3750 Zarathushti New Year starting March 20, 2012



As you may already know, the next Persian New Year celebration will mark the 3750th year since Asho Zarathushtra propounded his teachings to humanity. The core of his teachings, compiled in the Gathas, have brought us the earliest encouragements to strive for peace, social justice and attainment of righteousness. Aptly, in a world currently riddled with so much turmoil, we would like to mark this great occasion by creating awareness of his teachings. We would appreciate your advice and input on selecting themes for the celebrations, conferences, festivals, etc. The 'theme' should help convey the fact that the ancient teachings of Asho Zarathushtra, despite their chronological age are not only as fresh as the day they were delivered by him, but also can be very beneficial in the present era. In fact we want it to be known that his universal messages can help heal the world, offer hope to humanity, and bring solace to our world. The three themes we are proposing are as follows:

- 1- How Asho Zarathushtra's teachings can benefit the individual on a personal level and improve his/her life
- 2- How Asho Zarathushtra's teachings can benefit the community one lives in (neighborhood, city, state, country, etc.)
- 3- How Asho Zarathushtra's teachings can help improve and maintain the environment (dealing with environmental challenges)

We invite your suggestions for other similar topics or improvement of the above proposed ideas. Once we gather all input from individuals such as yourselves, we will announce the final themes and shall ask scholars and other interested parties to send abstracts of their articles and papers, so we may consider them as speakers in the Vancouver conference (details will be announced later).
